which aims to explore patterns of relationships, including couple and parenting relationships, and to improve effective communication, joint parenting, negotiated agreement and understanding of roles within the family



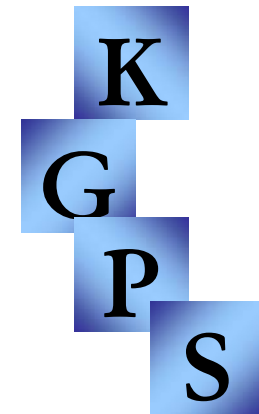

Adults

Separation and divorce are major life events which inevitably cause emotional and lifestyle upheaval and change. This challenges individual's abilities and resources for coping and adjustment.

Karen can offer assessment and therapy through separation and divorce to:

- support and enhance the process of adjustment and coping
- process emotions that may become overwhelming e.g. anxiety, stress, anger, loss and bereavement, low mood, low confidence and self-

Children and young people

Children may also struggle with their emotions and disruptions to the familiar. They may become confused and distressed about conflicted loyalties and protective feelings.

Karen can help parents to explore how they may:

- joint parent in changed circumstances
- identify and negotiate how to best meet the needs of their children

Karen can also work with individual parents when the other parent is unable to participate.

Occasionally it may be helpful for children to talk with Karen.

Through sensitively paced exploration together, strategies for coping with the emotional and practical upheaval of separation or divorce are explored.

Separating parents may wish to explore how they can improve their joint-parenting of children and better understand their children's needs and difficulties.
